EMERGING ENTREPRENEURS

In-Person

Every September, RCEO invites incoming first year Rotman Commerce students to its annual intern recruitment event. At this information session, students are welcomed to the Rotman Commerce community by a panel of RCEO members, alumni, and local entrepreneurs. The event provides students with the opportunity to network with industry professionals, fellow students, and compete for the chance to win a guaranteed interview spot in RCEO's first-year intern program.

Online

In the event that COVID-19 poses a threat to in-person events, RCEO will hold an event online through Zoom. The schedule remains the same.







BUSINESS ETIQUETTE WORKSHOP & NETWORKING

In-Person

This event is held in collaboration with the University of Toronto Faculty Club and Rotman Commerce Students' Association. In the competitive business industry, etiquette is another tool that provides students with an extra edge during recruitment. In addition to professional coaching for Canadian business etiquette techniques, this event will also include a panel discussion and a networking session.

Online

In the event that COVID-19 poses a threat to in-person meetings, RCEO will host an online business etiquette class instructed by the Faculty Club's general manager over the Zoom platform. An open networking session held over zoom will be held to facilitate conversations.

WOMEN ENTREPRENEUR NETWORKING PANEL

In-Person

This event is held in collaboration with the Rotman Commerce Women In Business association (RCWIB) where we invite 3 women entrepreneurs to share their journey. The events team from RCEO and RCWIB will be paneling and moderating this event by asking career-related questions proposed by the audience. Through this event, we hope to inspire young female students into pursuing a career in entrepreneurship.

Online

If COVID-19 still poses a threat to in-person meetings, this pitch competition will be held over UofT Blackboard Collaborate virtually.

NETWORKING NIGHT

In-Person

RCEO's annual networking night strives to inspire Rotman students with stories that entrepreneurs have. Held in January 2021, the RCEO networking night invites 10 entrepreneurs to meet 60 Rotman students in a more casual setting in downtown Toronto. This is an opportunity for startups to share their personal story and recruit for summer interns.

Online

RCEO is prepared to take the event online if COVID-19 concerns continue. Students will be able to partake in an online networking night with representatives on Zoom.

INNOVATION SYMPOSIUM

In-Person

The Innovation Symposium conference is held in collaboration with three main student associations. The conference-style event seeks to equip and inspire undergraduate students to leverage new technological developments and entrepreneurial strategy to help advance their careers in finance and other commerce-related fields. Themes may include practical applications of artificial intelligence, machine learning models, automation processes in capital markets professions like banking and trading, and the emergence of new techoriented businesses which are adapting to rapidly changing financial markets.

Online

There are no contingency plans developed yet for the conference. RCEO will continue monitoring the COVID-19 situation and implement new plans accordingly.

LAUNCH YOUR BIG IDEA

A chance to win seed funding

Launch Your Big Idea (LYBI) is an annual pitch competition, giving away \$10, 000 CAD of cash prizes to help entrepreneurs to transform their business ideas into reality. This event, in collaboration with the Rotman Commerce Program Office, and Rotman Commerce Sales Group, is a seven-week intensive training program that provides resources to help students identify a business idea that addresses any market gaps in the business industry. Prior to the pitch date in March, applicants will have access to workshops, coffee chats, and consultation sessions to provide them with guidance.

Online

If COVID-19 still poses a threat to in-person meetings, this pitch competition will be held over UofT Blackboard Collaborate virtually.









BOUNDLESS CASE COMPETITION

This year, RCEO is excited to expand our annual flagship event by increasing the level and quality of competition, the length of our event, and the introduction of workshops to add value for our competitors. This competition is divided into two rounds -- preliminary and final. The preliminary round is held completely online in mid-October, where 50 teams of four solve a real business problem faced by a company. After the preliminary round, we invite the top 10 teams to the final competition day in January 2021. Held in Myhall at the University of Toronto, the top 10 finalists receive the opportunity to present their refined business idea to our case partner and a panel of 10 judges.

DAY 1 October 25th, 2020: Preliminary Competition (online only)

DAY 2 January 24th, 2021: Final Round Competition

Online

While the preliminary round is held completely online, the final round competition is scheduled in-person in January 2021. However, RCEO is prepared to take the final competition day online if COVID-19 concerns continue. The final competition day will be facilitated over Zoom if COVID-19 still poses a threat to in-person meetings.
